Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, the AP® Program is introducing new resources and processes designed to help students earn college credit and placement. Here's what you and your student need to know:

- Students will be asked to pay and register for AP Exams in the fall.
- AP Exams will continue to be given in May.
- The exam fee isn't changing. However, there will be a \$40 cancellation or unused exam fee.
- Sparkman High School will collect \$94 exam fees until October 1st, 2019.
- Exam fees may be paid on my school fees.
- Students will get personalized feedback through new digital tools that provide daily support for every AP classroom. Their teachers will be able to track their performance throughout the year using monthly personal progress checks.

To get ready for the coming school year, please encourage your student to sign up for a College Board account. All College Board programs are connected through one account, so if your student created one for the PSAT/NMSQT®, SAT®, or College Board Opportunity Scholarships, they're all set.
